

In 2023 we continue to base our fees on the number of employees you have.

Our Committee believes this is the fairest and most equitable way for memberships to be calculated, remembering we are a not-forprofit organisation.

The scale continues to represent exceptional value given the complexities of employment, cost of payroll, and full-time access we provide to expert advice by email, phone or on farm visits.

Membership fees are based upon the number of Full Time Equivalent employees (FTE) you engage.

If you believe we have the incorrect employee number, please contact Andrew on 0407 200 909.

0-5 FTE \$480 + GST = \$528

6-10 FTE \$600 + GST = \$660

11-19 FTE \$720 + GST = \$792

20 or more FTE \$840 + GST = \$924

Full time equivalents are calculated using the following breakdown

1 Full-time employee = 1 FTE 1 Part-time employee = 0.75 FTE 1 Casual employee = 0.75 FTE 2 Seasonal employee = 0.25 FTE

Example:

The business employs 3 full-time employees, 3 part-time employees and 5 seasonal workers.

This equates to $3 + (3 \times 0.75) + (5 \times 0.25) = 3 + 2.25 + 1.25 = 6.6$ FTE

The fee payable is \$660.00

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
