Wage rates for New Apprenticeships and Trainees who are completing an Australian Qualification Framework Certificate Levels 1, 2 and 3



These rates are operative from the first full pay on or after 1st July 2022

This amended wage schedule incorporates the increase arising from the June 2022

Minimum Wage Decision of The Fair Work Commission

AQF CERTIFICATE LEVEL IV TRAINEESHIPS

Trainees undertaking an Australian Qualification Framework Certificate Level IV shall receive the relevant weekly wage rate for AQF Certificate III at Wage Level C, as applicable with the addition of 3.8% of that wage rate.

An <u>adult trainee</u> who is undertaking a traineeship for an AQF Certificate IV qualification shall receive the following weekly wage as applicable based on the allocation of AQF Certificate III qualifications.
